## THE END LESS CHAIN

The story is told of a young person who surprised herself by actually reading one of those religious tracts that are often handed out in public places. To her later amazement, she tells how significant one of those messages became for her brother and herself. The message dealt with what we owe God and how to respond to it. She recognized that the message on tithing had to do with her own faith and what she could do about it. Then she thought of her younger brother in a distant city who was going through a difficult time, financially. He had become engaged in litigation. He was "head over heels" in debt to his lawyers and was facing a hopeless future with a dependent family.

The young woman wasn't sure her brother would be receptive to the advice of a simple message on tithing, but she took a chance and sent the pamphlet to him. His previous approach to earning and spending wasn't working. Fortunately, he was ready to rebuild as a partner with God. Among other discoveries he found the biblical teaching on tithing to be, in his words, "one of the simplest and sweetest of all Bible teachings." Though tempted to delay his new resolve, he followed the advice his sister had sent to him.

Tithing is certainly not a gimmick to help us get out of rough scrapes, but it surely helps us to put our saving, spending and giving into better perspective. Actually the young man came through his difficulties in good shape and became an avid promoter of tithing. As new blessings became a reality, he found it thrilling to pass them on through the practice of tithing, extending "the endless chain."

### A Word About Camp

DOUBLING GAP CENTER, Home of Camp YoliJwa and once a turn of the century resort, took its name from the unusual lapping of the Blue Mountains which forms double gaps, resulting in a perfect horseshoe around the 150 acre facility. The famous Doubling Gap Springs Hotel attracted such famous guests as John Wanamaker and Ulysses Grant who sampled the nutritious white sulfur springs. TODAY, the historic hotel maintains the charm of former days but with a new purpose. The Center provides a secluded mountain setting for all ages and denominations to retreat, refresh, and renew their Christian faith. Although DGC is owned by the Eastern Regional Conference of Churches of God, they do not support the Camp monetarily. All monies come from the Camps and groups that use the facility.

CAMP YOLIJWA is the summer long variety of camps that take place at Doubling Gap Center. There are youth camps, family camp, wilderness camps, adventure camp, and even a Sr Life Camp! If you are unsure about camping for a week, Glenvale has it's church picnic at Doubling Gap Center so you can come to the picnic and check out the camp. Our church picnic is July 9 starting at Noon. Once you have experienced camp, you will want to come back again and again. The cost of camp this year is \$188.00 and Glenvale pays all but \$25.00 of the registration fee (the one signing up for Camp pays the \$25.00). We believe in the ministry of camp and want as many to go as possible.

And just in case you didn't know, YoliJwa stands for **Y**outh **L**iving **J**esus **W**ay!

**Our campers enjoy getting postcards and letters at camp, so on the Camp bulletin board is a list of the campers and the week they will be at Camp. So let's make the week for our campers and send them a postcard or letter! They must be in the mail by Wednesday of each week when you send them.**

Camp YoliJwa still needs weekly volunteer counselors for the 2011 summer camping program. Responsibilities include sharing your faith and guiding a group of 7 – 8 campers through daily routines, activities, and devotions. Age requirement is 16+ years. Specific needs are male counselors at all levels and any adults over 18 for Junior High camps and Youth Camp.
